BCAPA Dance Dress Code 2022-2023

All dancers are expected to:

- Wear their hair pulled back and away from their face while in class. Long hair should be in a bun for all ballet classes.
- Practice good hygiene- Please think of the others dancing in class with you!
- Refrain from wearing their dance shoes outside and in the parking lot. This brings dirt and grit into the studios which ruins the dance floor. Wearing shoes outside will also ruin dance shoes, causing parents to have to purchase new ones more frequently.
- Remember that wearing bras and underwear under leotards is not necessary. Leotards are made to provide support, but dancers may wear a sports bra or dance bra under their leotards if they would like.

If the dress code is not followed, one warning will be issued in class and parents will be notified. If the dress code is not adhered to after the first warning has been given then the dancer will be asked to sit out from class. Special situations can be discussed with the Dance Director and there will be extra time given at the beginning of the semester to obtain dance clothes. Students can find dance attire at **Attitudes Dancewear** at 625 N. Carriage Parkway in Wichita.

Creative Movement:

Dress Code- Leotard of any color (can have skirt attached), pink footless tights, bare feet.

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, bare feet.

All dancers will start wearing ballet shoes when they start the spring semester in January and will need transition tights by recital at the end of the spring semester.

Tap and Tumble:

Dress Code- Black camisole leotard and black leggings or transition tights of any color, black tap shoes. *Dress Code Option 2*- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black tap shoes. All- **Sneakers or tennis shoes that are not worn on the street or are cleaned before each class.**

Pre-Ballet:

Dress Code- Pink camisole leotard & pink transition tights. <u>Pink leather or canvas split-soled ballet shoes</u> (No satin ballet slippers).

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black leather or canvas split-soled ballet shoes.

Acro/Hip Hop Combo:

Dress Code- Black camisole leotard and leggings or transition tights.

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt.

All- Sneakers or tennis shoes that are not worn on the street or are cleaned before each class.

Beginning Ballet 1 and Beginning Ballet 2:

Dress Code- Black or blue camisole leotard, pink transition tights, <u>pink leather or canvas split-soled ballet shoes</u> (No satin ballet slippers). **Hair in a bun.**

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black ballet shoes.

Jump Into Ballet, Intermediate Ballet 1, Intermediate Ballet 2, Pre Pointe, Pointe, and Advanced Ballet:

Dress Cod- Solid colored leotard, pink transition tights, pink canvas split-soled ballet shoes.

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black ballet shoes.

All- Proper warm-ups may be worn during cold months if they are removed by the end of barre.

All levels of Jazz, Leaps and Turns, Conditioning:

Dress Code- Solid colored leotard, black convertible tights, black leggings or jazz pants optional, black slip on jazz shoes.

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black slip on jazz shoes.

All levels of Tap:

Dress Code- Solid colored leotard, black convertible tights, black leggings or jazz pants optional, black tap shoes. *Dress Code Option 2*- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black tap shoes.

All levels of Acro:

Dress Code- Solid colored leotard or fitted shirt, black convertible tights or leggings, bare feet. *Dress Code Option 2-* Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, bare feet.

All levels of Modern:

Dress Code- Solid colored leotard, black convertible tights, black leggings or jazz pants, bare feet. *Dress Code Option 2*- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, bare feet.

All levels of Irish:

Dress Code- Solid colored leotard or fitted shirt, black convertible tights, leggings or jazz pants, black split-soled slip on jazz shoes.

Dress Code Option 2- Black athletic shorts and a solid colored fitted t shirt, black split-soled slip on jazz shoes.

All levels of Hip Hop:

Fitted shirt or top with leggings or black athletic shorts (can be worn over tights and a leotard if needed). **Sneakers or tennis shoes that are not worn on the street or are cleaned before each class.**

Adult Classes: Unless otherwise specified by the instructor workout clothes and socks are appropriate.

Kaleidoscope Dance Company Members (RDC, SDC, EDC) will need the following items:

Skin toned camisole leotard Black camisole leotard Ballet pink transition tights Black transition tights

Skin toned stirrup tights Black leggings (no visible logos, designs, or sparkles)

Black slip on jazz shoes Ballet shoes- split soled

Skin toned slip on jazz shoes

Company dancers are to come prepared to dance in every rehearsal- hair pulled back, leotard, tights, & all dance shoes. Please have the above items by the 3rd week of classes.
